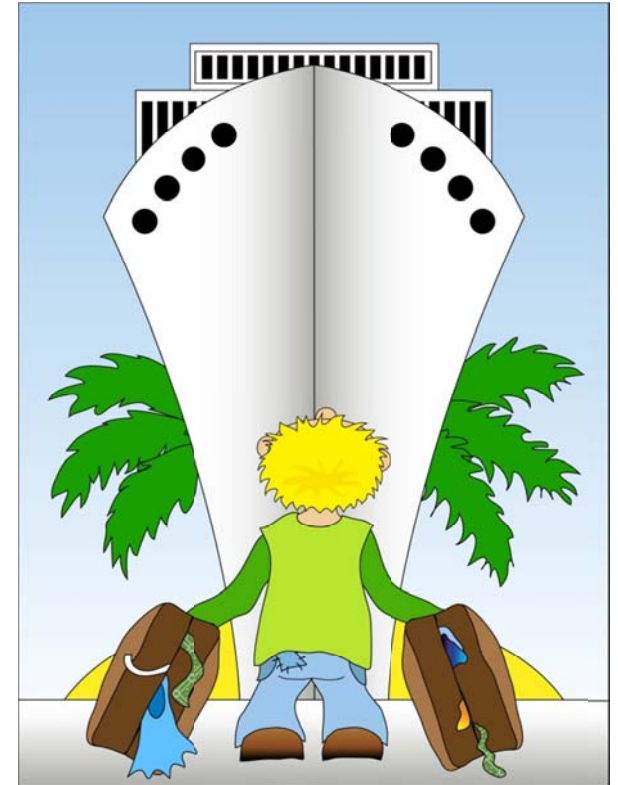

There might be lots of people but I won't have to wait long. It's almost time to go on the ship!



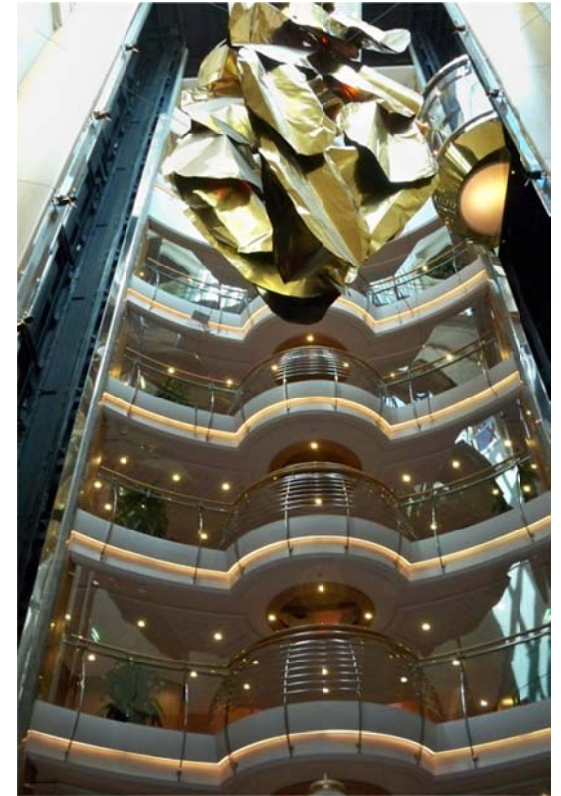
Boarding the Ship...

Exploring the ship is a fun way to see everything.

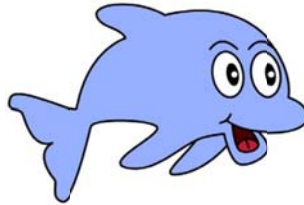


Exploring the Ship...

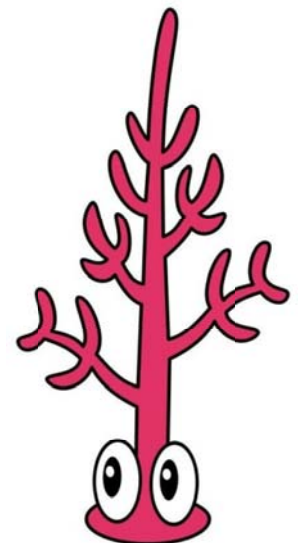
Finding my Cabin...
